General Discussion

BEGIN OVERVIEW OF SCHOOL PERFORMANCE PLAN

- Christina Fitch provided handouts on School Planning/Improvement Planning and explained how multiple sources of data are studied and then used to inform the direction and action that our school will take through our Improvement Plan. Four types of data are collected: Demographics, Perceptions, Student Learning and School Processes. The data is analyzed and used to make decisions on curriculum, programs and continuous improvement so that we have successful students.
- Staton has a School Leadership Team consisting of the Principal, Assistant Principal, grade level representatives, staff and the PTO President. This team has been going over the data and will present it to the SOT at our next meeting.
- A question was asked about how student projections are used to determine our per student funding. A spring school student projection is made and then budget allocations are provided accordingly. The final budget allocation is made from Count Day in the Fall. Rick Baldwin (Zoning/Demographics) is in charge of school projections. In the past, we are able to protest our school projection if there was a disconnect. In the 2017/2018 school year, more money will be allocated to the schools if they grow more than 10 students from count day until December 31st.
