7. Pioneer Nights- Rachel Henry

- Thank you so much Rachel: so many great choices for pioneer nights and treat trucks!
- Hoping to have a skate night in January. Glittering lights are still going on until January 7th and \$5 per car comes back to Staton.
- Trying to figure out when to start treat trucks again: looking at coffee or hot
 chocolate ones. Look at In and Out but they have asked for \$2,500 in
 guaranteed profits to be booked. Will look at other trucks.
- Savana Bananas: Basketball game which is fun for kids: June 22nd, looking into this.
- Silver Knights game: April 7th at 1pm (Sunday) is the date for this. Every ticket gains \$3 back to Staton and they are \$20 each. Tim is the lead on this and has spoken to their event coordinator who says that if we sell 200 tickets than all of the kids who come can be in a group picture down on the ice.

8. Pizza day and swag shop- Heather Booth

They also do the 1st day of school supplies: list is created by all the teachers in each grade level in January so that they make the packs for ordering beginning in April. The school supplies go to Staton but backpacks ordered will go to home address. They also have water bottles that can be personalized and will have stick on labels soon.

9. SS4S- Aubany Glancz

- Date is Thursday, February 22nd to be held right after school.
- CCSD still needs to approve equipment if having during school hours but if the approval doesn't come through then right after school.
- Ordering T-shirts soon so getting sizes from teachers for all students: helps to order correct amounts of each T-shirt size.
- Need sponsors for this: \$500 which means they get their name on the T-shirts, banners, and can have a booth at the race.
- There will be two rounds of runs to accommodate the students.
- The T-shirts will be green and the theme is BLOOM. Mrs. Cram is working on the lessons that go with the theme for each day.
- Kickoff will be the Friday the week before and the fundraising starts on that Wednesday. There will be incentives everyday and the fundraising will be open til the Sunday after the race.
- The T-shirts will be held back and delivered to the teachers the day before the race to disturb on the day of the race to the students.
- Incentives will be like last year but there will be laser tag instead of the bowling. Running in the halls, mini golf at the school, etc.
